



Open-Access Bibliography 2023-2024

Revaluing Care in the Global Economy invites entries for our [Open-Access Bibliography](#) that seek ways to open up the question of valuing care. This bibliography has three principal objectives:

1. To provide a resource for researchers, journalists, and policymakers who may want to learn more about the field of care studies and any of its subfields.
2. To increase visibility of relevant research that may not be readily evident through most research databases, which tend to favor widely cited, English-language research.
3. To provide a vehicle for mapping the field of care studies and examining the ways concepts and keywords do or do not travel and translate among different contexts.

The bibliography is not predicated upon a particular definition of the term care, and we particularly welcome contributions that identify and contribute to filling gaps in the bibliography. To that end, we will prioritize proposed entries that expand the bibliography's linguistic, geographical, and topical coverage.

For the academic year 2023-2024, we will offer two opportunities:

- 1) In an effort to continue to develop our open-access [bibliography of care research](#), we are offering \$400 course-development grants to instructors interested in incorporating the Zotero bibliographic development into either graduate or undergraduate classes,. Instructors will be provided with written materials and a virtual training that explains how to develop the bibliographic entries and ideas for incorporating bibliographic assignments into their classes. Applicants should plan to teach the class during the 2023-24 academic year. **Those interested should submit a brief (c. 250-word) class description or current syllabus and a short (c. 100-word) bio to revaluingcare@gmail.com by June 1st, 2023.**
- 2) Also, a payment of \$250 will be awarded for selected individual applicants. To be considered for this prize, please propose at least 5 articles or 3 articles and 1 book (the number of entries required for payment). Final submissions can be in any language; the bibliography will include an English translation as well as the original language.
